Scholarships for MBA PROGRAMMES

The decision to undertake an MBA programme and find the business school that best suits your needs and expectations can be a formidable one. For this reason, EADA would like to thank you for putting your trust in us.

In order to help our candidates finance their studies, every year EADA offers a wide range of scholarships. Please find the requirements for applying to these scholarships below.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

Scholarship applications are available to all candidates who have successfully completed the admission process and paid **25% of the total fee** of the MBA Programme.

Special enrolment cancellation conditions apply to scholarship applicants. Unsuccessful scholarship applicants who cancel their enrolment within 10 working days of not being awarded the scholarship will be refunded all the payment(s) made towards the programme minus an administrative fee of 300€. After 10 working days, the normal cancellation conditions will apply.

AWARD COMMITTEE

The applications are assessed by a committee made up of members of the General Management of EADA.

A consensus agreement will identify the winning candidates.

OBLIGATIONS

All scholarship recipients commit themselves to participating in the MBA programme with a high level of dedication and excellence.

The scholarships given by EADA commit participants to collaborating in a research project. The project will be assigned by the school and carried out during the MBA programme.

In submitting the application, candidates agree to the terms and conditions described in this brochure.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

The first application deadline is Friday, March 16, 2012.

Any remaining scholarships will be awarded after the second application deadline, Friday, May 18, 2012.

REQUIREMENTS

- A copy of the **admission letter** issued by EADA.
- A **letter introducing yourself** and explaining why you are an outstanding candidate for the scholarship.
- A **letter of recommendation** from your professional or academic background. (This recommendation must be written by someone other than the two references used during the admission process.)
- A **list of other activities** that you are involved in such as: student associations, professional forums, sports, etc.

RESULTS

The winning candidates from the first deadline will be contacted by Friday, April 13, 2012.

The winning candidates from the second deadline will be contacted by Friday, June 1, 2012.

The requested documents must be **received** by May 18, 2012.
