EADA Business School is once again in the Top 20 worldwide for executive training and strengthens its position by entering the Top 40 for business training

- The prestigious British Financial Times ranking recognizes the institution's international reach and the strength of its executive training offering, placing it at number 19 in the Open Programs category.
- The institution's corporate training improves its ranking and is ranked 39th worldwide, responding to the realities of business.

Barcelona, June 2, 2025. EADA Business School strengthens its position among the world's most renowned business schools, according to the **Executive Education 2025** ranking, published today, Monday, by the Financial Times. For the third consecutive year, EADA is among the Top 20 worldwide in the Open Programmes category, reaching nineteenth place this year. This result reinforces its key role in national executive training, the school's international reach, and consolidates the strength of its executive training offering, which includes programmes such as the <u>Senior Management Programme in Sustainability</u>, the <u>General Management Program (PDG)</u>, and two specific management and leadership development programmes.

At the same time, the ranking publishes the global ranking for the <u>Custom Programmes</u> category (programmes for companies). For the first time, EADA has managed to reach the Top 40 worldwide, reaching position 39, a significant improvement compared to the 46th position it achieved in 2023. This progression demonstrates the impact of its customized training for companies, adapted to current reality as well as the strategic needs of each organization.









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The ranking prepared by the Financial Times evaluates various aspects such as faculty quality, methodological innovation, student diversity, internationality, and the schools' infrastructure.

The Dean and Director General of EADA Business School, **Jordi Díaz**, comments that "our institution was born for management training, and today, 68 years later, we not only continue to respond to the business world, but this is a clear recognition of our track record."
